Please speak to Carol to arrange payments.

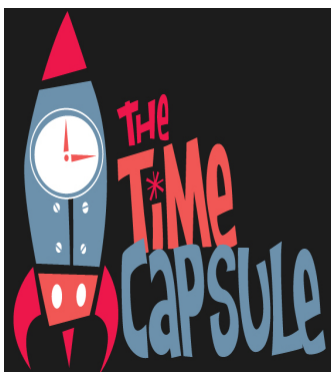
All accounts must be up to date prior to booking your children into care.
